Girls Social Skills Group for teens with Autism Spectrum Disorders addresses issues pertaining to:

- Interpersonal skills
- Problem solving
- Managing behavior & emotion
- Self-acceptance

This group is accepting females, 13-15 years old with Autism Spectrum Disorders. Sessions are held weekly on Tuesdays from 4:00-5:00 p.m. and are ongoing.

Group sessions focus on immediate needs and issues participants present to the group, as well as common themes. Sessions are a combination of processing and engagement in activities to help facilitate social interaction.
